By the way, the food waste consists of clam miso soup, bamboo shoot peels, and burnt miso-glazed sablefish.





forming in the water.



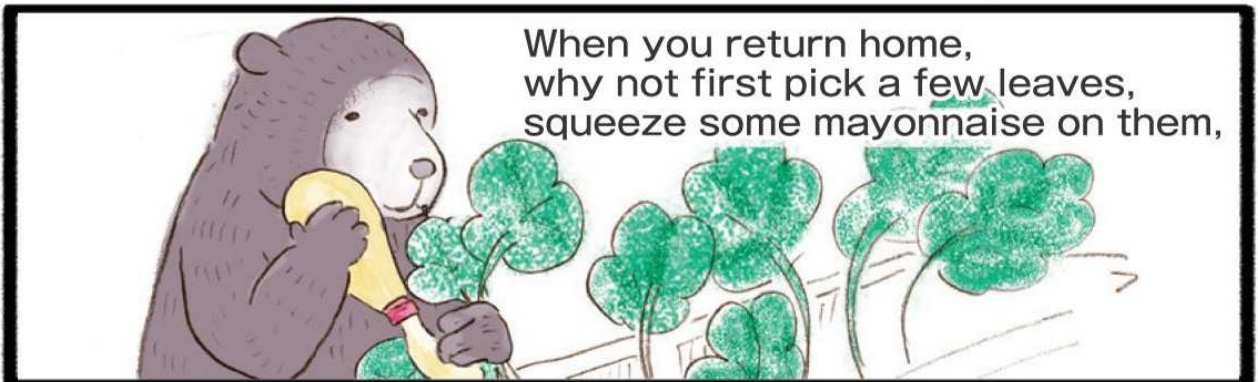
They will repeat cell division and

is full of greenery.



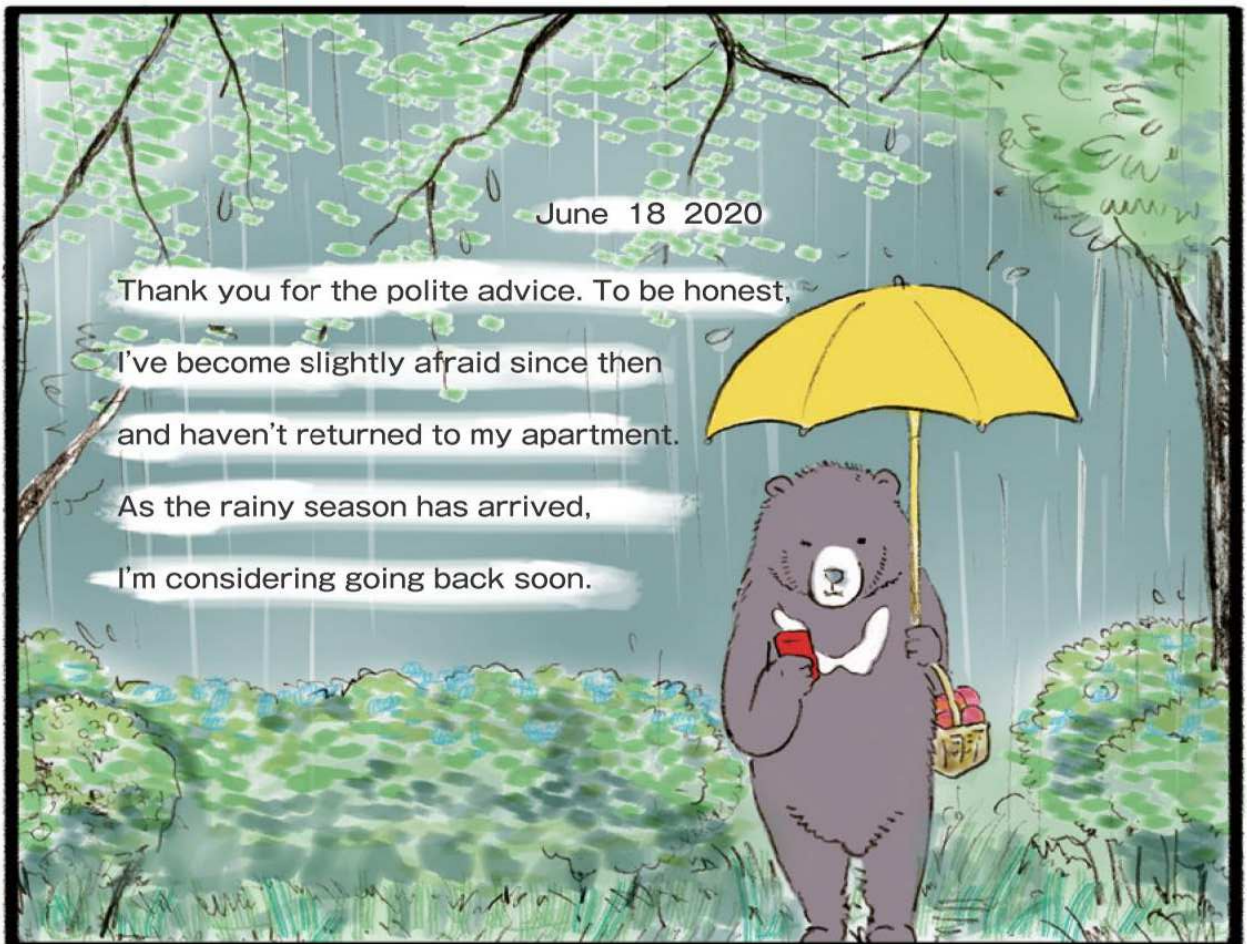
Perhaps the wind is blowing

onto the cutting board.

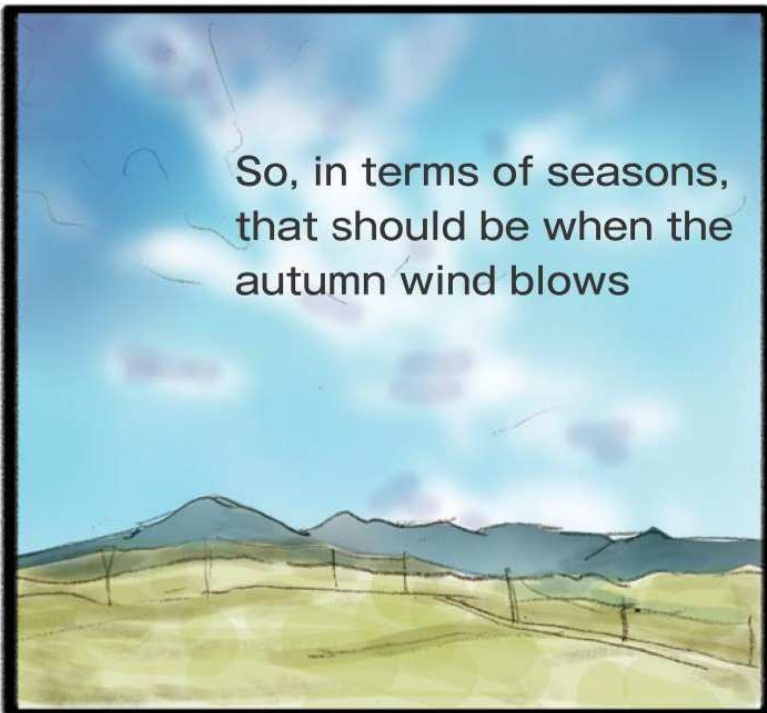




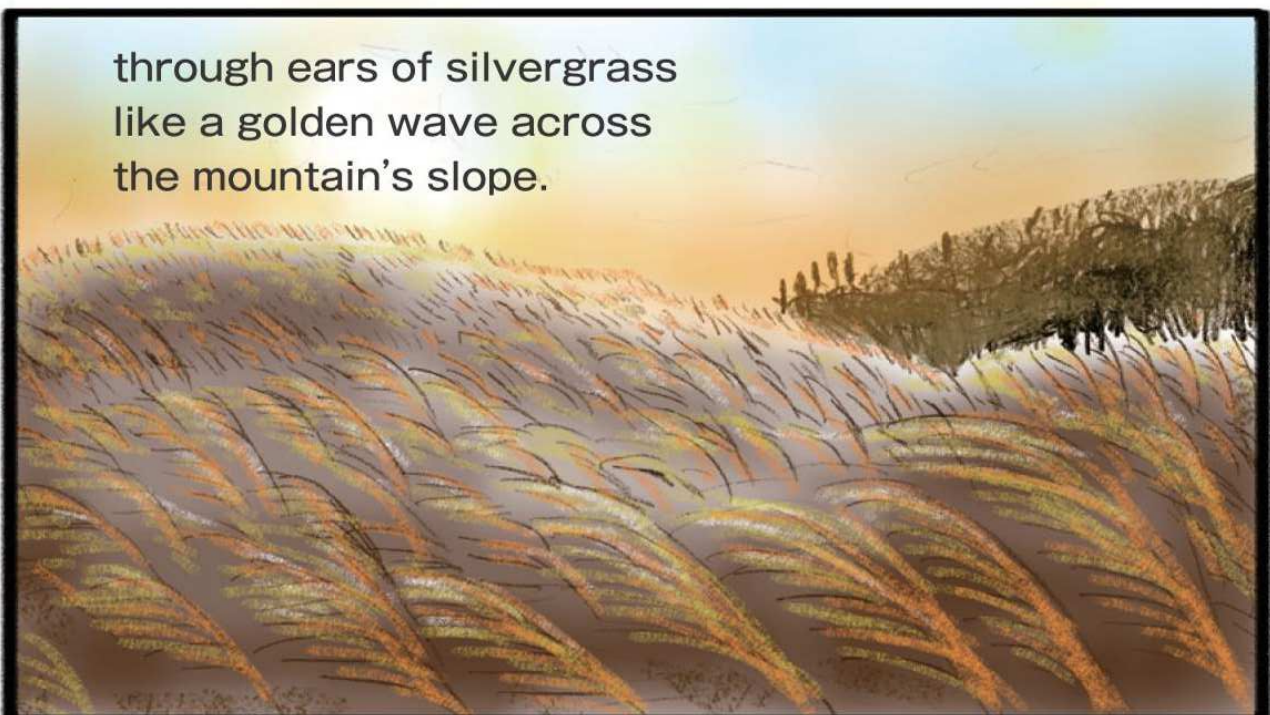
Because amphibians will climb
into a pot all on their own.



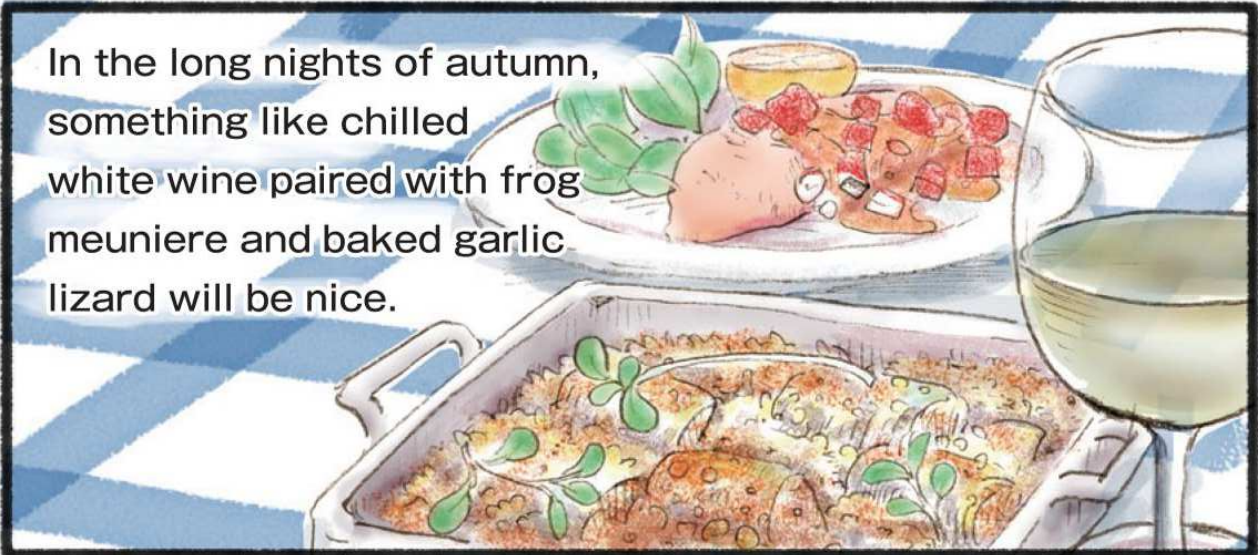
So, in terms of seasons,

the mountain's slope.

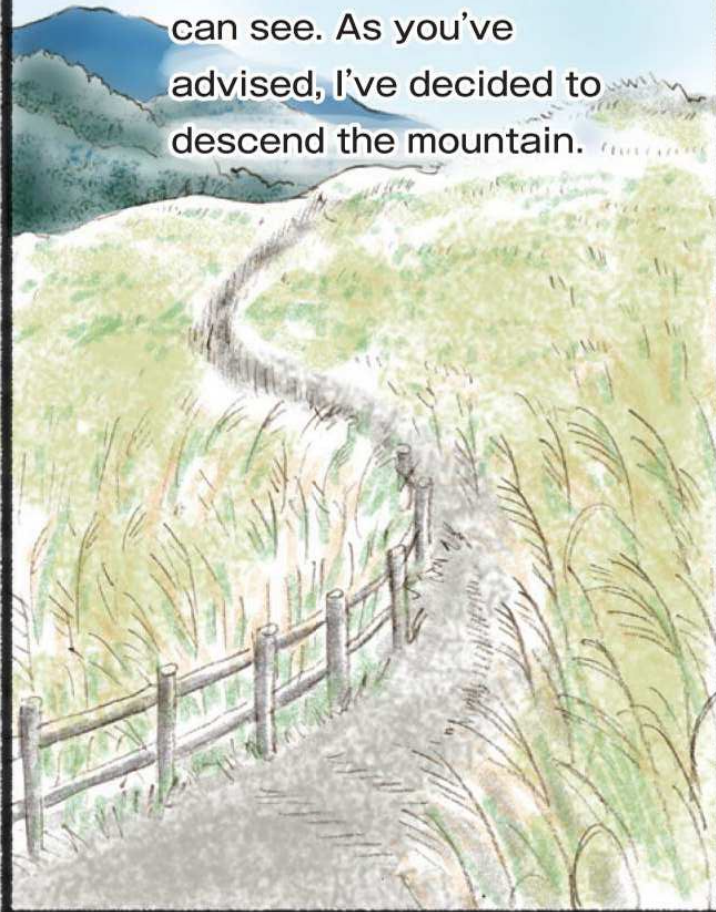


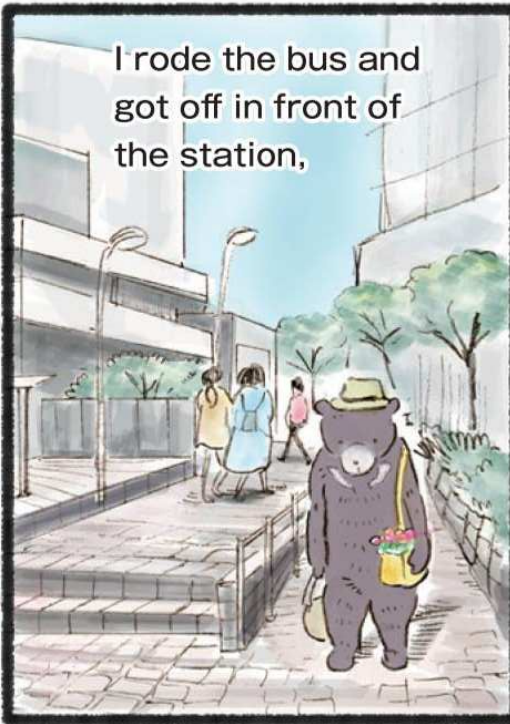

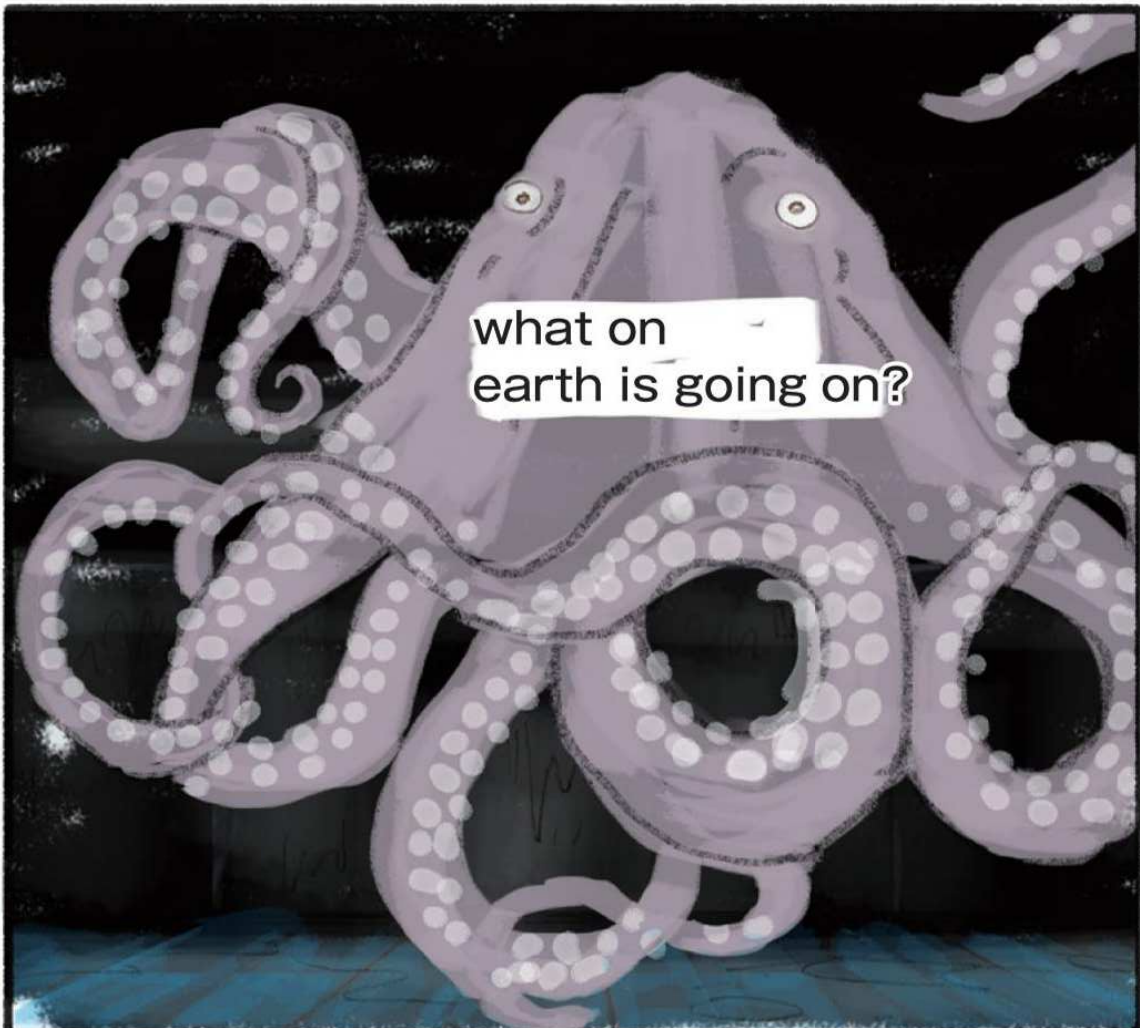

descend the mountain.

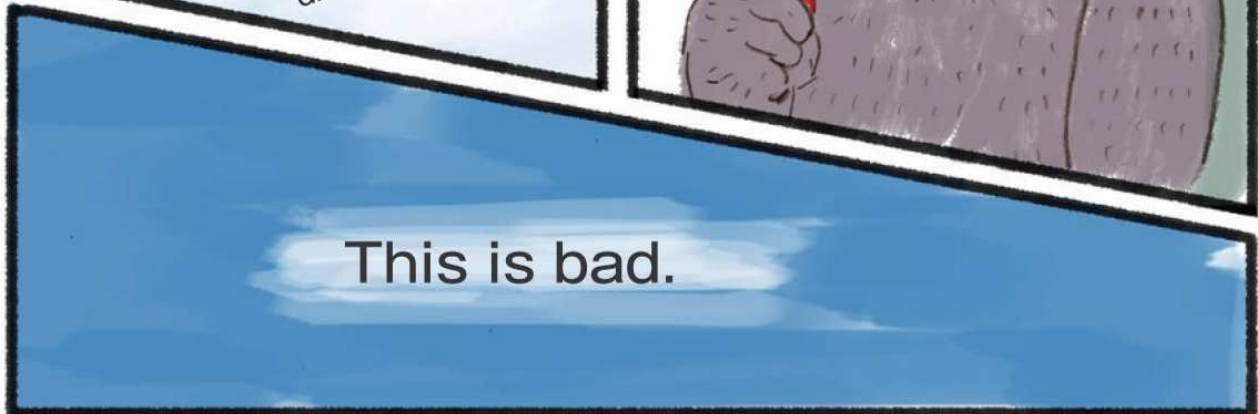
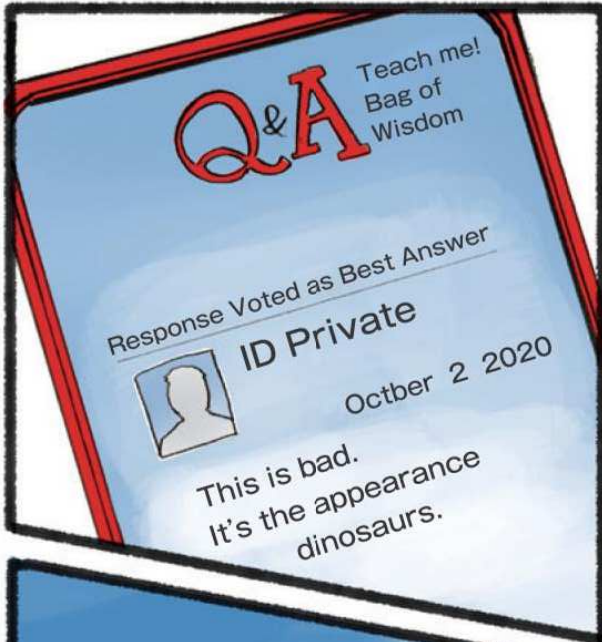




It doesn't seem to be

of dinosaurs.

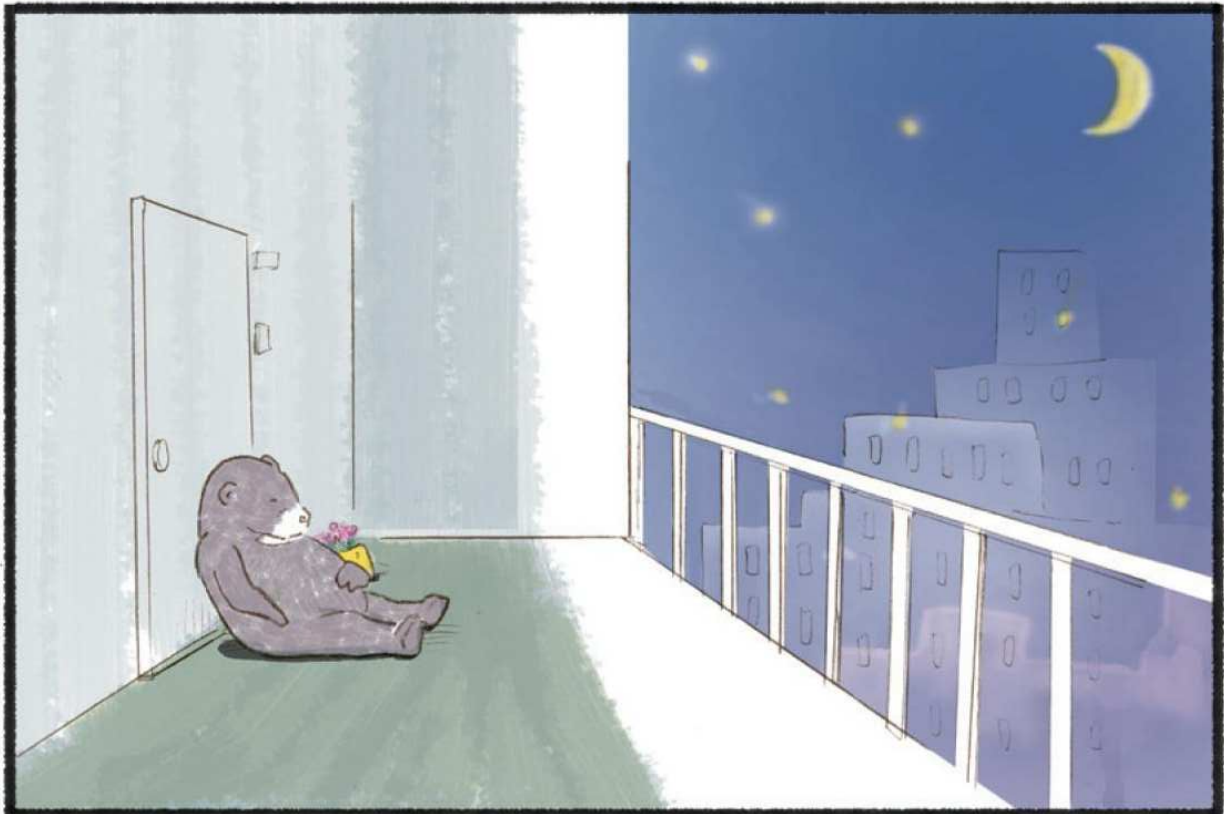
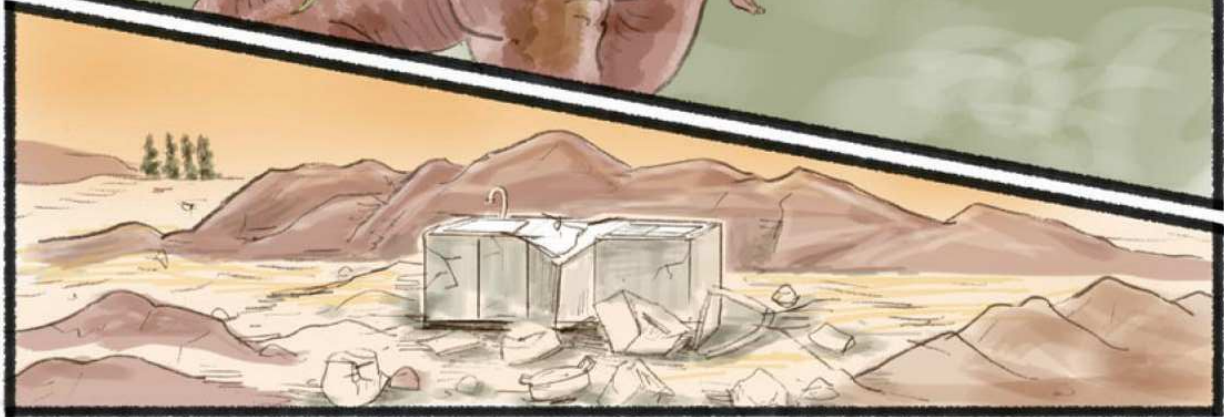
