Tottori Port lies in the east of Tottori Prefecture, which is situated almost in the middle of the Sea of Japan side of western Japan. The port has been developing as a hub of sea routes connecting the Korean Peninsula, Izumo, Oki, and Tajima Island. Attractive sightseeing spots, such as the "Tottori Sand Dunes", "The Sand Museum", and "Uradome Coast",

are situated near the port. Furthermore, you can visit and enjoy "The Nageiredo Hall of Sanbutsu-ji Temple", a national treasure built on a steep mountain cliff, and "Akagawara-Shirakabe Dozogun Storehouses", the old buildings and streets remaining in Kurayoshi City, both situated in the middle of Tottori Prefecture.

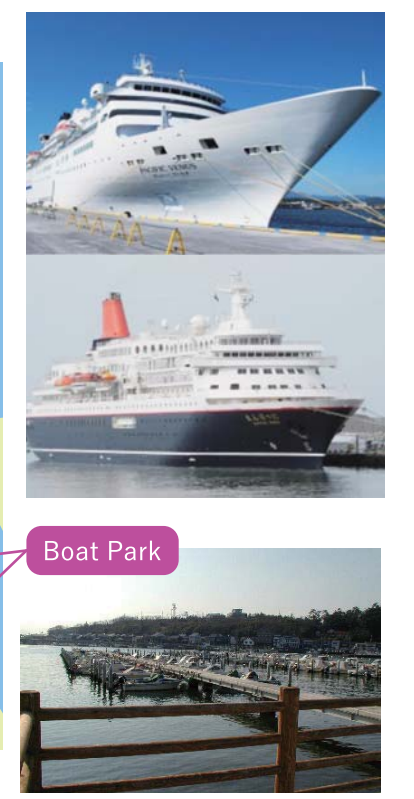

<b>Welcome Ceremonies</b>	We can prepare Japanese drum performances, Shan-shan Umbrella Dance performances, presentation of souvenirs, exhibition of your cruise ship as a sand statue and similar at the wharf.
<b>Introducing Japanese Culture</b>	We can prepare a hot water "foot bath" with water from a natural hot spring, as well as stalls where you can buy unique products made in Tottori or eat our local cuisines at the wharf.
<b>Tourist Information Center, Currency Exchange</b>	We can prepare a tourist information stall on the ship or on the wharf. Available at banks in Tottori City.
<b>Shuttle Bus Services</b>	The shuttle bus takes the visitors to and from "Marine Peer Karo", where you can find seafood markets, a farming and livestock product market and a crab aquarium, all bustling with tourists.
<b>City Sightseeing for Crews</b>	The crews can also join the shuttle bus tour. Also, free public wireless Internet access is available at the main sightseeing spots and public facilities in Tottori City.
