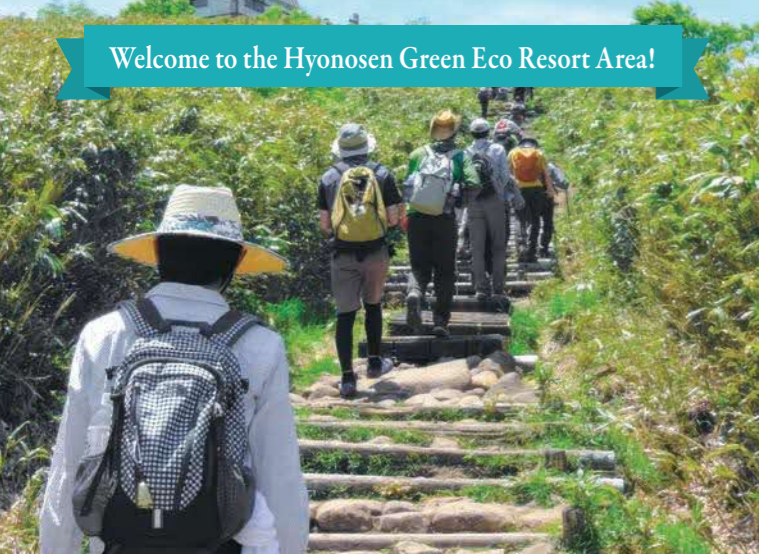


Mt. Hyonosen Climbing/Hiking Map

When hiking on Mt. Hyonosen, be sure to submit a Climbing/Hiking Notification at the nearest facility or at the Hiker Registration Office.

■ Climbing/Hiking Completion Notification

When you leave the mountain area, be sure to submit a Climbing/hiking completion notification form (or notify authorities by telephone that you completed the hiking trip).

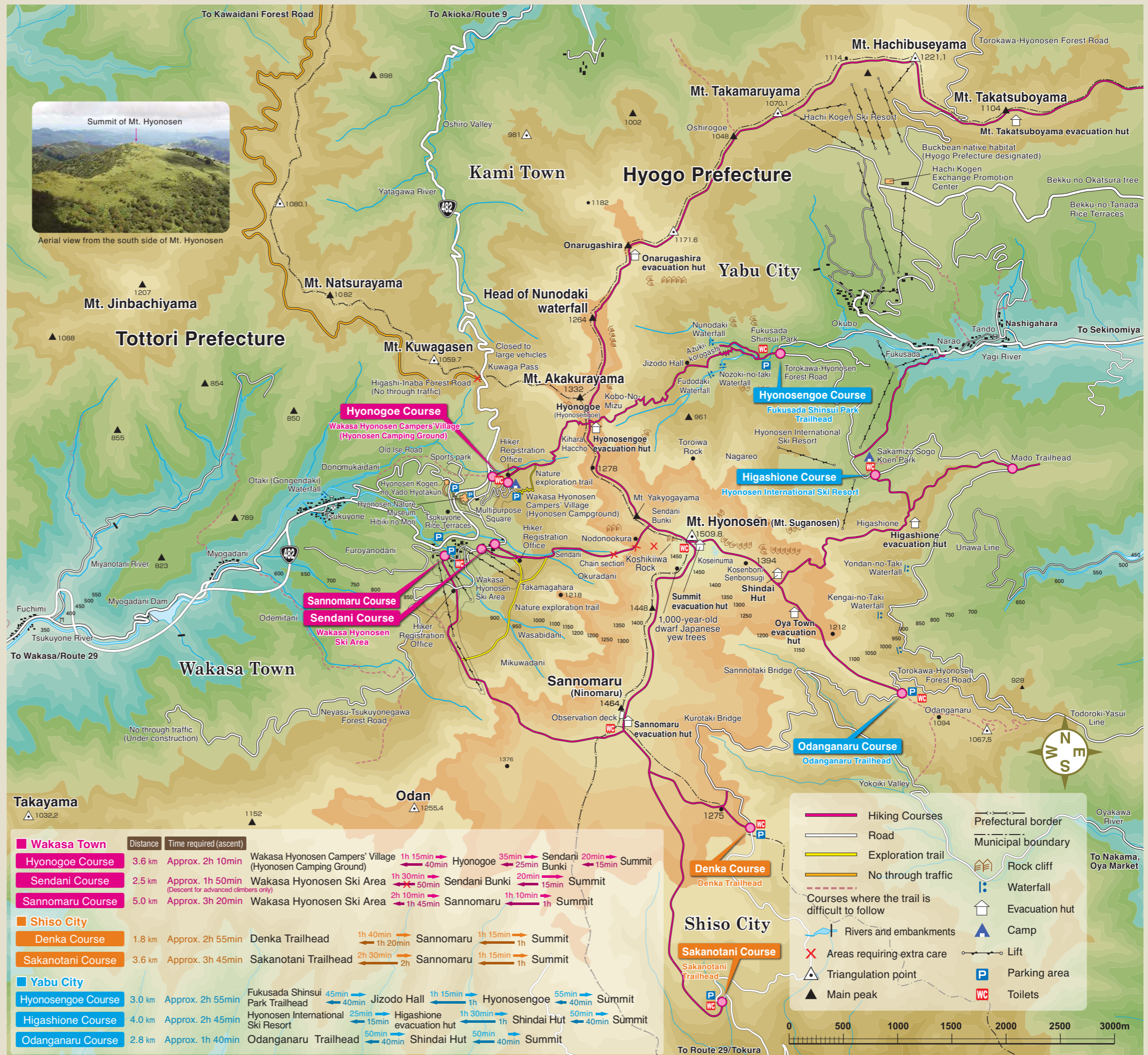

● Tsukuyone Rice Terraces



One of the Top 100 Terraced Rice Fields of Japan. Natural water from Mt. Hyonosen and the day-night temperature difference due to the high altitude nurture the delicious, terraced rice field rice.

Sightseeing Information

● Bekku-no-Tanada Rice Terraces



This rice terrace landscape features layer upon layer of paddy fields. When the fields are filled with water, an upside-down image of Mt. Hyonosen is reflected on the water surface, creating a spectacular sight.

● Tendaki Waterfall (One of the Top 100 Waterfalls of Japan)



This famous waterfall with a 98m drop flows down like showers from the sky. Along the mountain trail to Tendaki Waterfall you can enjoy forest bathing. The waterfall is 1.2 km from the trailhead or approx. 45 minutes one-way.

● Nakaze Mine Checkpoint



At the mine there is a display of actual mine trolleys that were in use until 1969. You can also request a guided tour (reservations required).

● Togayama Onsen Tennyo-no-Yu



These natural hot springs bubble up quietly in an area blessed with abundant nature. Containing many minerals, onsen water is called a "beauty bath" because it fits skin benefits.
